Ribbons and Prizes

There will be ribbons for 1st through 4th placing and qualifiers in each jump height category.

Notice to Exhibitors

- **No refunds** except in the case of an injury to a dog. In such a case a veterinary certificate is required. Under these circumstances \$10.00 may be withheld to cover postage and handling.
- There will be no refunds, cancellations or changes after the closing date, except for bitches in season and move-ups as per AAC regulations Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of AAC Rules and Regulations, including, but not limited to, the following:
- This event is held under AAC Rules and Regulations (as of 2007) and is open to all dogs being at least 18 months of age, purebred or mixed breed, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance, or dogs showing signs of aggression.
- Obstacles shall be chosen from those described in the current edition of the rules and regulations of the AAC and shall conform to AAC specifications.
- No leads, collar, food, toys, or any other aids or devices shall be permitted on course at any time; this includes obstacle familiarization.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may be asked to leave the show grounds. In such cases, no refund of fees will be paid.
- All dogs must be kept in their ex pen or crate or on leash when not in the ring. All dogs must be in control when leaving the ring after their run. Any dog engaging in aggressive or out-of-control behavior upon exit of the ring will be disqualified and/or be required to leave the show grounds. In such cases, no refund of fees will be paid.
- Exhibitors must keep crate and exercise areas clean. Please pick up after yourselves and your dogs.
- Veterinarian on call list provided at check-in.
- Please only exercise your dogs in designated areas. Do not make any contact with the turf. Thank-you.
- Crating area provided INDOORS

For descriptions of classes offered refer to the AAC rule book.

Special Classes – These classes are open to all dogs but are intended for dogs that are of a size or stature which limits their jumping ability. There will be no double or spread jumps and the A-Frame will be set at 5 feet.

Veteran Classes – These classes shall be for dogs seven years of age or older that are currently competing in any Standard Agility Class and for dogs five years of age or older

who have competed in the Specials Agility Class for a minimum of one calendar year.

Directions to Kelowna Dog Sport Centre

From the North: on Highway 97 you will pass the airport and the turnoff to the University of British Columbia – Okanagan and then go over an overpass. Immediately after the overpass, turn East (left) onto Hereron Road. Turn North (left) almost immediately onto Bulman Road. You will see a sign telling you about golf courses. Watch for the Kelowna Dog Sport Centre sign on the right. There is also a sign saying Macdonnell Turf Farm. Turn right and drive down to the red barn and park on the North side.

From the South/West: Travel through Kelowna on Highway 97 and as you are leaving the city turn right just before the overpass onto Hereron Road. You will notice signs for golf courses as well. Turn North (left) almost immediately onto Bulman Road. You will see signs telling you about golf courses. Watch for the Kelowna Dog Sport Centre sign on the right. There is also a sign saying Macdonnell Turf Farm. Turn right and drive down to the red barn and park on the North side.

AAC ID Cards

If your dog does not have an AAC ID card, please order it yourself before the trial. **All dogs MUST have an ID card to compete in AAC events.** These cards are used to record the dog's height and eliminate the need for measuring when they have been signed by the required number of judges. I/We hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damages because bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting thereof, sustained by any person or persons, including myself/ourselves or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my/our participation in this event, howsoever such injuries, death or damage to property may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents or any other persons.
